Report: 2013–2014 “More better . . .”

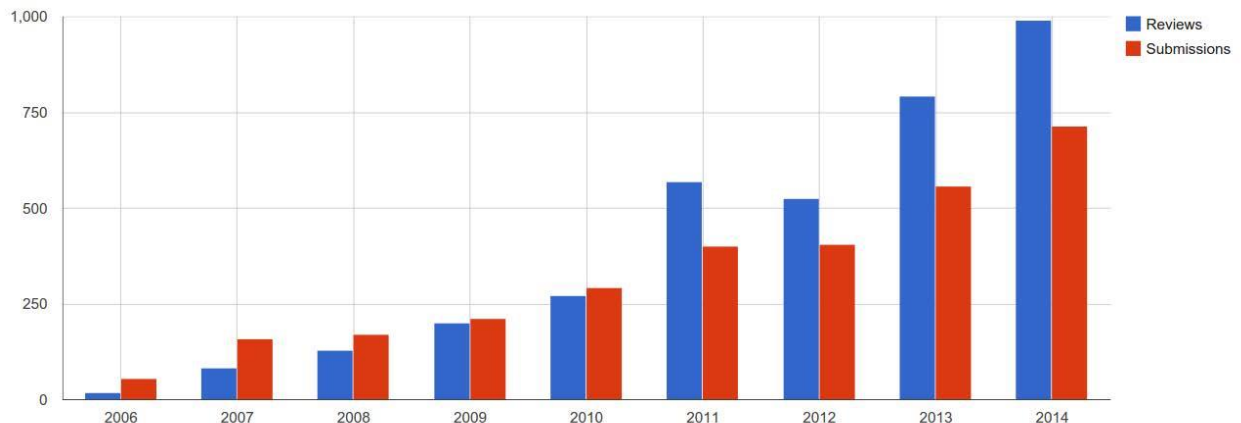


Figure 1. IJoC annual publication figures 2006–2014.

The ***International Journal of Communication (IJoC)*** is now in its ninth year and continuing to exceed its own performance each year. Beginning in 2007 with 159 submissions, we had more than 700 submissions in 2014 (see Figure 1). In 2007, we had 1474 registered users, at the end of 2014, we had 10,784.

In 2013, in addition to 74 research articles, IJoC published 42 articles in five guest-edited Special Sections [our version of Special Issues]; in 2014, we published 85 research articles and 65 articles in six Special Sections on topics ranging from WikiLeaks to Big Data to Transmedia Storytelling to Arab Revolutions. We also initiated a new category, the Forum, guest-edited by Henry Jenkins and Nick Couldry, that elicited 41 short commentaries from scholars on the topics: Creativity, Labor, Politics, Knowledge and Education, and Platforms. We published 61 book reviews in 2014, somewhat down from our high of 80 in 2013 (see Table 1 for details).

By way of comparison, the *Journal of Communication*, which now publishes six issues each year, published 58 articles in 2013 and 56 articles in 2014. *The Journal of Communication* published 10 book reviews in 2013 and eight book reviews in 2014.

In 2007, we received submissions from authors in 13 countries; in 2014, our submissions came from 66 countries. Not surprisingly, the largest number of submissions continues to come from the United States, but there are 23 countries from which we have received 10 or more submissions [at the moment, unfortunately, the largest number of submissions cannot be identified by country of origin, but we are modifying our required metadata in order to obtain this information—see Tables 2 and 3 for details].

Our performance as measured by the various assessment metrics continues to strengthen. In the latest reports from Google Scholar, IJoC ranks 15th among all Humanities, Literature and Arts journals, and seventh among Communication journals. It is notable that we are by far the newest journal to be at the top of these lists. The next youngest journal among the Humanities list, *Gender & Society*, was founded in 1987 and only four of the top 15 were founded after 1977. Among the top seven Communications journals, only *New Media & Society* [1999] and the *Journal of Computer-Mediated Communication* [1995] come at all close to IJoC in youth.

Annenberg Press E-books

When we last reported on the activities of the Annenberg Press in 2013, we previewed the launching of our next venture, e-books. This new and exciting frontier in scholarly publishing has since been opened, and we have now published a total of 10 e-books that are available from Amazon, iTunes, Kobo and Nook. Our first e-books were derived from IJoC Special Sections, and included *Piracy Culture*, edited by Manuel Castells and Gustavo Cardoso; *Academic Labor*, edited by Jonathan Sterne; and *Breaking Boundaries*, edited by Dannagal G. Young and Jonathan Gray. More recently, we published *WikiLeaks: From Popular Culture to Political Economy*, edited by Christian Christensen. We also published the complete works of visual communication pioneer Sol Worth, edited by Larry Gross and Jay Ruby.

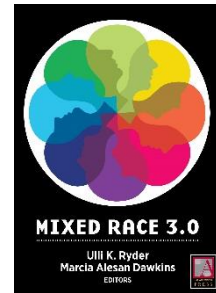
Taking advantage of the affordances provided by e-publishing, we have now published a number of innovative original e-books that go beyond what can be accomplished in print, although in some cases we have also made it possible to obtain print copies, on demand, through Amazon. Our original e-books include: *Thinking Together: An E-mail Exchange and All That Jazz*, by Howard S. Becker and Robert R. Faulkner, is the actual record of the collaboration through which these two distinguished scholars wrote a book about how jazz musicians communicate. The discussion includes hyperlinks to recordings of performances they are discussing.

Echoes of Gabriel Tarde: What We Know Different or Better 100 Years—work by Elihu Katz, Christopher Ali and Joohan Kim—analyzes Tarde’s 1898 classic “Opinion and Conversation” and illuminates the subsequent century of research on mass communication. The e-book utilizes hyperlinks to take the reader from Tarde’s essay to the authors’ analysis to the bibliography, and back.

WARNING! Graphic Content: Political Cartoons, Comix and the Uncensored Artistic Mind, by award-winning political cartoonist Mr. Fish, examines the past, present and future of art as commentary. The e-book includes interviews, audio and visual clips and nearly 400 provocative images. This will also be available as a large format print-on-demand book.

Mixed Race 3.0: Risk and Reward in the Digital Age, edited by Ulli K. Ryder and Marcia Alesan Dawkins, and with a foreword by Herman Gray, brings together the views of 17 writers, researchers and artists to examine the varied experiences of being “multi-racial” today.
